Joining Instructions

- Runners should arrive by 8.00 a.m. dressed for the event, displaying their allocated number on their vest front and with tags attached to their shoes
- Bags and labels will be available to transport tracksuits, etc. to the finish (see signs – the van will be located in the St Nicholas Park car park).
- Bus transport is available from Kenilworth Castle back to the St Nicholas Park car park, Warwick.

Fun runners - please allow serious runners to begin at the front.

The route:

- **Start** Timing starts at the exit Gate from St Nicholas Park, Warwick

On leaving the park **turn right**
then go via

- St Nicholas Church St,
- Coventry Rd,
- Spinney Hill roundabout,
- Warwick Rd
- through Leek Wootton turning left at the Anchor Public House into
- Woodcote Lane,
- Rouncil Lane,
- Mortimer Rd,
- Dudley Rd,
- Latimer Close
- Beauchamp Rd,
- Oaks Rd,
- Caesar Road
- Fishponds Rd,
- Brookside Ave,
- Castle Rd

to enter the Castle through the gate opposite the Queen and Castle public house to

- **Finish** inside Kenilworth Castle

Kenilworth:

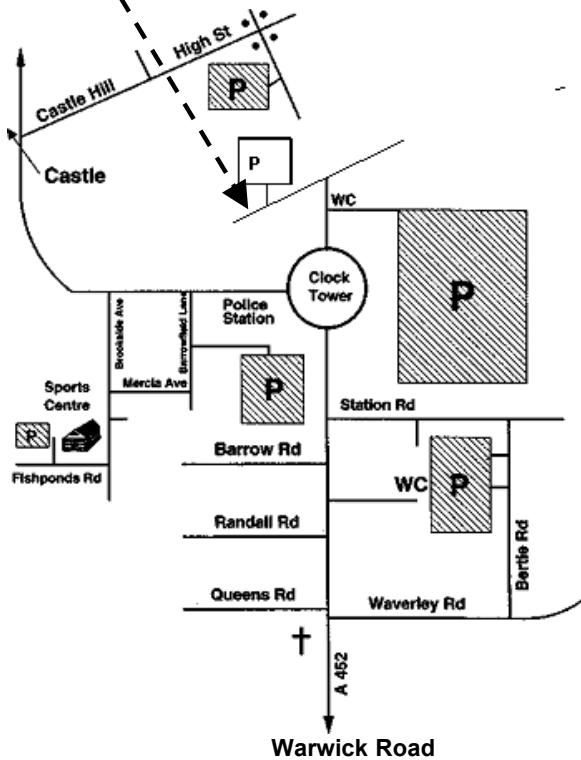
Major road works will close Warwick Road, Kenilworth at the time of the run and you should allow adequate time in case of delays which are likely to be severe

There is no parking at The Brays or Castle Green Car Parks beside Kenilworth Castle.

Public car parks are located

- to the rear of the shops in the Town Centre,
- Abbey Fields Car Park (off Bridge Street)
- Castle Farm Sports Hall Car Park (off Fishponds Road - See map).

If dry there will be temporary parking (from 8.30 am to 1.00 p.m. only) on Abbey Fields (access from Forest Road).



No parking is permitted in Malthouse Lane or High Street (police will be patrolling and issuing parking tickets to anyone parking here).

Please note – there will be road closures in place on the approaches to Kenilworth Castle from 9.00 – 11.00 am approx. so spectators should allow ample time to park and get to the finish.

Safety warning

Runners are subject to the Highway Code and must keep to the side of the road or use pavements to avoid accidents.

Please note – *signs will be taken down and marshals withdrawn progressively from 9.30 a.m. and any walkers or slow runners will be deemed to have dropped out of the official event once passed by the team collecting the signs. Those reaching The Anchor Public House in Leek Wootton after 10 a.m. will be deemed to have dropped out of the run*

Race Numbers/Tags

- **Race numbers must be pinned to vest front.**
- **Where more than one number is sent you must wear the number allocated to you.**
- **No number = no prize/medal/T Shirt - so keep your number pinned to your shirt after the finish as proof of entitlement to t shirt/medal.**
- **All finishers must return their timing tag on completing the run**

Presentations

Presentations commence at 10.00 a.m. and will be made by the Mayor of Kenilworth accompanied by the President of the Rotary Club of Kenilworth and representatives of our main sponsors
